'MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING'

This MoU made on this the 07th day of March, 2011 at Hyderabad.

Between

M/s Electronics Corporation of India Limited, a manufacturing unit of Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India, and a company registered under companies Act 1956, having its registered office at ECIL Post, Hyderabad-500 062 (hereinafter referred to as ECIL)

AND

M/s Society for Electronic Transactions and Security, a society formed at the initiative of the office of Principal Scientific Adviser to Government of India with Members from Government, Industry, academic institutions etc. registered under the Societies Registration Act XX1 of 1860 with Registration No.S42605 of 2002, and having its operational headquarters at MGR Knowledge City, C.I.T Campus, Taramani, Chennai- 600 113 (hereinafter referred as SETS)

Whereas ECIL is engaged in developing, manufacturing, marketing and rendering servicing support of variety of electronic equipment.

Whereas SETS aims (a) to promote the study and dissemination of knowledge in the area of Information Transaction, with particular reference to Information Security, (b) to develop exclusive technologies as well as make available technologies developed by it for national security agencies and (c) to participate in collaborative activities with other researchers and institutions/organizations in the area related to Information Security.

The scope of participation of ECIL and SETS in this development project is as given below:

1. Having worked together in the area of development of Bulk Encryption Unit under the project named BEEG, ECIL and SETS will work together further in developing encryption units depending on ECIL's interest to meet the future requirements pertaining to networks and crypto-devices.
2. ECIL being a commercial organization would be responsible for front-ending business opportunities and for providing total turn key solutions to the end users. In case, SETS identifies some potential customers for its know-how and SETS approach is acceptable to the customer, ECIL would consider providing solutions to such customers as per SETS recommendations and would work along with SETS.

3. ECIL may use its in-house expertise in design, development of prototype, etc. and also independently carry out its own development. Similarly SETS is free to take up research assignments with other agencies without violating IPR terms and conditions.
4. SETS being focused in basic and applied research in information security will provide necessary backend research and related support to ECIL in development of encryption units/devices on mutually agreed terms.
5. SETS will continuously endeavor to do research work in encryption units and inform ECIL about new developments for commercial exploitation.
6. SETS would offer manpower and necessary expertise to work on specific solutions needed to be developed for specific customers on mutually agreed terms.
7. Any export business would be handled by ECIL, and SETS will offer necessary manpower qualified for the job/task.
8. ECIL and SETS will share technical information relating to information security devices jointly developed by them including BEEG. IPRs relating to all the existing and future work shall be with ECIL or SETS depending on the fact who is the originator of the applicable concept/innovation
9. This MoU will be valid for a period of 3 years.
10. Shri V Satyanarayana, GM, IT&TG will be the nodal point of contact from ECIL.
11. Shri S Thiagarajan, Registrar will be the nodal point of contact from SETS.
12. Any dispute will be resolved jointly by Director (Technical), ECIL and ED SETS.
