

## **ABOUT SETS**

Society for Electronic Transactions and Security (SETS) is an initiative of the Central Government through the Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser (PSA) to the Government of India, SETS was established for the purpose of nucleating, sensitising and developing technologies that can protect the information wealth of the country. Such an idea to form a specialized organisation in the area of information security was conceived by Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, formerly the Hon'ble President of India and was implemented by Dr. R.Chidambaram, PSA to the Government of India. SETS is the first organisation in India established in the Public-Private Partnership mode that is engaged in information security. SETS has its headquarter at Chennai close to IITM Research Park in Taramani. SETS is engaged in the research areas of hardware security, network security and cryptology. SETS has signed various MoUs with leading Institutions specialising in information security. SETS has initiated a programme with Institute of Mathematical Sciences (IMSc) to engage in research in Cryptanalysis.

## THEME OF THE WORKSHOP

Data security for merchants and payment card processors is the vital byproduct of applying the information security best practices found in the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS). The Standard includes 12 requirements for any business that stores, processes or transmits payment cardholder data. These requirements specify the framework for a secure payments environment, but for purposes of PCI DSS compliance, their essence is three steps: Assess, Remediate and Report.
