# About - IAITSS, SETS, QUT and IITM

Indo-Australian IT Security Society is a registered trust which works to foster Indo-Australian collaboration in IT

Security. It works closely with Governments, Academia, Professional Bodies and Industry on a range of IT security issues.



Society for Electronic Transactions and Security (SETS) is an initiative of the Central Government through the Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser (PSA) to the Government of India. SETS was set up for the purpose of nucleating, sensitising and developing technologies that can protect the information wealth of the country. Such an idea to form a organisation in the area of information specialized security was conceived by Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, formerly the Hon'ble President of India and was implemented by Dr. R.Chidambaram, PSA to the Government of India, SETS is the

first organisation in India established in the Public-Private Partnership mode that is engaged in information security. SETS has its headquarter at Chennai close to IITM Research Park in Taramani, Chennai, with the Advanced Facility in Information Security and Cryptology (AFISC). SETS is engaged in the research areas of hardware security, network security and cryptology. SETS has signed various MoUs with leading Institutions specializing in information security, as a part of this SETS has initiated a programme with Institute of Mathematical Sciences (IMSc) to engage in research in Cryptanalysis.

Queensland University of Technology (QUT) is a highly successful Australian university with an applied emphasis in courses and research. Based in Brisbane with a global outlook, it has 40,000 students, including 6000 from overseas and an annual budget of more than AU\$500 million. Courses are in high demand and its graduate employment rate is well above the national average for Australian universities. Over the years, QUT has grown and changed. From the establishment of the Brisbane School of Arts over 150 years ago, QUT has been at the forefront of innovation and progress in tertiary education.

The campus is located in the city of Chennai, previously known as Madras. Chennai is the state capital of Tamil Nadu, a southern state in India.
