1. Introduction:

Society for Electronic Transactions and Security (SETS) intends to engage an experienced and qualified service provider for the Annual Maintenance Contract (Non-Comprehensive) of the existing Fire Alarm System (FAS), Public Announcement System (PAS), and Access Control System (ACS) installed at SETS premises.

The AMC is proposed to ensure the continuous, reliable, and efficient functioning of the systems through periodic preventive maintenance and timely breakdown support during the contract period. Sealed quotations are therefore invited from empanelled vendors of SETS having experience in maintenance and servicing of the above systems, as per the terms and conditions specified in this document.

2. Specifications and Scope of the Work:

The Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) shall be **non-comprehensive** in nature for the maintenance of the following systems installed at the premises of the Society for Electronic Transactions and Security (SETS), Chennai:

- a) **Fire Alarm System (FAS)** – Detailed equipment list enclosed as **Annexure – I**
- b) **Access Control System (ACS)** – Detailed equipment list enclosed as **Annexure – II**
- c) **Public Announcement System (PAS)** – Detailed equipment list enclosed as **Annexure – III**

The scope of the AMC shall include monthly preventive maintenance, routine inspection, testing, servicing, troubleshooting, fault diagnosis, breakdown maintenance, and restoration of the systems to ensure their safe, reliable, and uninterrupted operation throughout the contract period. The AMC shall also cover all associated equipment, software interfaces, power supply units, batteries, networking components, cabling, accessories, and peripherals forming part of the above systems.

3. General Obligations of the Contractor

The contractor shall:

- Carry out monthly preventive maintenance of all systems covered under the AMC, resulting in a minimum of twelve (12) preventive maintenance visits during the contract period, as per the approved maintenance schedule.
- Attend and rectify all breakdown complaints within the stipulated response time.
- Deploy qualified and experienced technical personnel for maintenance activities.
- Maintain proper maintenance records, logbooks, and service reports, and submit them to SETS after each preventive maintenance visit and breakdown service.
- Obtain prior written approval from SETS before replacing any defective spare parts, consumables, or components. Since the AMC is Non-Comprehensive, the cost of such replacements shall be borne separately by SETS.

- Comply with all safety, security, and access control procedures applicable within the SETS premises.

4. Maintenance of Fire Alarm System (FAS)

The contractor shall carry out preventive maintenance, inspection, testing, and servicing of the Fire Alarm System (FAS) to ensure that the entire system remains fully operational and capable of responding effectively under fire alarm conditions.

The following activities shall be carried out during each preventive maintenance visit:

1. At least one initiating device (smoke detector, heat detector, or manual call point) from each loop/zone shall be activated to verify the ability of the Fire Alarm Control Panel to:
 - Receive alarm signals correctly;
 - Display the alarm condition;
 - Operate hooters, strobes, and other warning devices;
 - Activate all configured control functions and interfaces.
2. Where multiple zones or loops are installed, representative devices from each zone/loop shall be tested to verify proper operation of the system.
3. Testing activities that may result in audible alarms shall preferably be carried out on Saturdays, holidays, or during non-working hours in consultation with SETS to minimize disturbance to regular activities.
4. The Fire Alarm Control Panel, networking modules, power supply units, and batteries shall be visually inspected for:
 - Moisture ingress;
 - Corrosion;
 - Physical damage;
 - Loose connections;
 - Abnormal indications or fault conditions.
5. A visual inspection shall be conducted to identify any structural, occupancy, or layout changes that may affect the effectiveness or positioning of:
 - Smoke Detectors;
 - Heat Detectors;
 - Manual Call Points (MCPs);
 - Response Indicators;
 - Hooters and Strobes.
6. All detectors, modules, manual call points, and associated devices shall be inspected, cleaned, and tested as required to ensure proper functionality.

7. The contractor shall verify loop continuity, communication integrity, and proper functioning of all field devices connected to the system.
8. Any fault, defect, abnormality, or malfunction detected during inspection or testing shall be recorded in the maintenance logbook and immediately reported to the designated SETS representative. Necessary corrective action shall be taken promptly.
9. The contractor shall ensure that the fire alarm system remains fully addressable and capable of automatically identifying:
 - Detector faults;
 - Open circuit conditions;
 - Short circuit conditions;
 - Device communication failures;
 - Panel faults;
 - Power supply failures.
10. Any defective detector, module, cable connection, interface device, or panel component identified during maintenance shall be repaired or replaced after obtaining approval from SETS.
11. A detailed service report indicating the tests performed, observations, faults identified, corrective actions taken, and recommendations shall be submitted after each maintenance visit.
12. The contractor shall ensure that the Fire Alarm System remains operational, reliable, and compliant with the original system design throughout the AMC period.

5. Maintenance of Access Control System (ACS)

The contractor shall provide comprehensive preventive and breakdown maintenance services for the complete Access Control System installed at SETS, including hardware, software, controllers, readers, biometric devices, power supply units, electromagnetic locks, magnetic contacts, networking components, and all associated accessories.

The scope of maintenance shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

a) Access Control Software

- Maintenance, troubleshooting, reconfiguration, and restoration of the existing Access Control Software.
- Reinstallation or replacement of software, if required, due to software corruption or system failure.
- Any software installed or replaced by the contractor during the AMC period shall be covered by a minimum warranty of one (1) year from the date of installation.

b) Preventive Maintenance

- Periodic inspection and preventive maintenance of the entire Access Control System.

- Verification of communication between controllers, readers, biometric devices, and the management software.
- Submission of preventive maintenance reports after each maintenance visit for record purposes.

c) Electromagnetic Locks and Door Hardware

- Cleaning and inspection of electromagnetic locks, armature plates, magnetic contacts, and associated hardware.
- Adjustment and alignment of locks and door mechanisms to ensure smooth and reliable operation.
- Verification of door release functionality during normal and emergency conditions.

d) Card Readers and Biometric Devices

- Cleaning and inspection of card readers and biometric terminals.
- Verification of reader performance, response time, and communication with controllers.
- Alignment, calibration, and configuration checks wherever applicable.
- Replacement recommendations for defective devices, subject to approval from SETS.

e) Control Panels and Relays

- Inspection and testing of controllers, locking relays, interface modules, and associated electronic components.
- Verification of proper operation of both main and standby locking relays.

f) Power Supply and Battery Backup

- Inspection and testing of power supply units (SMPS).
- Verification of battery charging status, battery health, backup duration, and charging circuits.
- Reporting of weak or defective batteries requiring replacement.

g) Server and Host Monitoring

- Verification of server connectivity, database communication, and reporting functions.
- Checking event logging, access reports, attendance reports, and user database integrity.
- Verification of backup and restore functionality of the Access Control System software.

h) Fault Rectification

- Attendance and rectification of breakdown complaints within the stipulated response time.
- Diagnosis and correction of faults affecting controllers, readers, locks, software, network communication, and associated devices.

i) Documentation

- All maintenance activities, observations, faults identified, corrective actions taken, and recommendations shall be recorded in the maintenance logbook.
- A detailed service report shall be submitted to SETS after each preventive maintenance visit and breakdown service.

j) System Availability

- The contractor shall ensure reliable and uninterrupted operation of the Access Control System throughout the AMC period and shall take all necessary measures to maintain system performance in accordance with the original design and functionality.

6. Public Address and Mass Notification System (PAS)

The contractor shall maintain the Public Address and Mass Notification System in a fully operational condition throughout the AMC period and ensure that the system meets the intended performance requirements at all times.

The scope of maintenance shall include inspection, testing, servicing, troubleshooting, and rectification of faults pertaining to amplifiers, speakers, microphones, control consoles, zone selectors, interfaces, power supply units, cabling, and associated accessories.

The contractor shall:

- a. Carry out periodic preventive maintenance and functional testing of the complete system.
- b. Verify the audibility, clarity, and zone-wise operation of announcements.
- c. Check the performance of amplifiers, microphones, speakers, control units, and associated equipment.
- d. Attend breakdown complaints within the stipulated response time and take immediate corrective action.
- e. Make all reasonable efforts to rectify reported defects on the same day of complaint registration.
- f. Ensure that the downtime of any critical equipment does not exceed seven (7) calendar days.
- g. In cases where repair is likely to exceed seven (7) days, the contractor shall provide suitable temporary replacement equipment of equivalent or higher specifications, without any additional cost to SETS, until the original equipment is restored to service.
- h. Submit maintenance and service reports after each preventive maintenance visit and breakdown service.

The contractor shall ensure reliable and uninterrupted operation of the Public Address and Mass Notification System throughout the AMC period.

7. List of Equipment:

The equipment quantities indicated in Annexure-I, Annexure-II, and Annexure-III are indicative and approximate and are provided for guidance only.

The bidders are advised to inspect the site and verify the installed equipment before submission of their quotation.

Any variation in quantity, model, configuration, location, or installed condition of equipment identified during site inspection shall be deemed to have been considered by the bidder while submitting the quotation.

No additional claim, compensation, or revision in AMC charges shall be entertained by SETS on account of any variation in the quantity or configuration of equipment covered under the AMC.

The successful bidder shall be responsible for maintenance of all equipment installed and connected to the Fire Alarm System (FAS), Access Control System (ACS), and Public Address System (PAS), including associated accessories, interfaces, power supplies, and interconnecting cabling, irrespective of whether each individual component is specifically listed in the annexures.

8. Submission of Quotation

1) The quotation shall be submitted under a **Two-Cover System** comprising:

- **Cover-I: Technical Bid**
- **Cover-II: Financial Bid**

2) Both covers shall be separately sealed and enclosed in a single outer sealed envelope superscribed as:

"Quotation for Annual Maintenance Contract (Non-Comprehensive) of Fire Alarm System (FAS), Public Announcement System (PAS) and Access Control System (ACS)"

- 5) Incomplete quotations, conditional quotations, or quotations received after the prescribed due date and time shall be summarily rejected.

- 8) The Technical Bids will be opened on the same day at **03:30 P.M.** in the presence of the Purchase Committee.
- 9) The Financial Bids of only those bidders who are found technically responsive and eligible shall be opened subsequently on a date and time to be intimated by SETS.
- 10) SETS reserves the right to accept or reject any quotation, wholly or partly, without assigning any reason thereof, and its decision shall be final and binding on all bidders.

9. General Terms and Conditions:

1. The AMC shall be non-comprehensive in nature for the Fire Alarm System (FAS), Public Announcement System (PAS), and Access Control System (ACS).
2. The AMC period shall be for a duration of One year(s) from the date of commencement/order.
3. The vendor shall carry out periodic preventive maintenance and attend breakdown complaints during the AMC period.
4. The vendor shall ensure proper functioning of all systems covered under the AMC with minimum downtime.
5. The vendor shall attend breakdown complaints within the stipulated response time communicated by SETS.

6. The AMC charges shall not include the cost of spare parts/components. Any replacement of defective parts shall be carried out only after obtaining approval from SETS.
7. The vendor shall deploy qualified and experienced service personnel for carrying out maintenance activities.
8. The vendor shall submit service reports after every preventive maintenance visit and breakdown service.
9. The vendor shall follow all safety and security procedures while working inside the SETS premises.
10. SETS reserves the right to inspect the maintenance activities carried out by the vendor at any time.
11. Payment shall be released after satisfactory completion of services and submission of invoices along with service reports.
12. SETS reserves the right to accept or reject any or all quotations without assigning any reason thereof.
13. In case of unsatisfactory service, repeated delays, or non-compliance with the terms and conditions, SETS reserves the right to terminate the AMC at any stage.
14. Any damage caused to the existing systems/equipment due to negligence of the vendor or its personnel shall be rectified/replaced by the vendor at their own cost.
15. The decision of SETS in all matters relating to the AMC shall be final and binding on the vendor.

10. Additional Eligibility / Qualifying Criteria:

Fire Alarm System (EST3 Programming Capability)

- a) The bidder shall possess and maintain its own **EST3 Programming Dongle** for configuration, programming, troubleshooting, modification, and maintenance of the existing EST3 Fire Alarm System installed at SETS.
- b) The service engineer proposed to carry out EST3 programming and maintenance shall possess a **valid EST3 Programming License/Certification** issued by the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) or its authorized training agency. Copies of the valid programming license/certification shall be enclosed with the Technical Bid for evaluation.

11. Validity:

The contract shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of award of contract, with an option for extension for a further period of up to two additional years (1+2 years) at the same rates, terms, and conditions, subject to satisfactory performance of services on a year-to-year basis and at the sole discretion of SETS.

12. Payment Terms and Conditions:

- a) Payment shall be made to the Service Provider on a quarterly basis, subject to satisfactory performance of the AMC services and upon submission of bills/invoices after completion of each quarter.
- b) The AMC contract shall be based on the comprehensive/non-comprehensive rate for the complete system, including necessary peripherals and accessories. If the bidder quotes the rate without indicating the tax component separately, the quoted rate shall be treated as inclusive of all applicable taxes and duties.
- c) Tax Deducted at Source (TDS) shall be deducted from each bill of the vendor as applicable under the provisions of the Income Tax Act and Goods & Services Tax (GST) Act.
- d) Any increase or decrease in taxes, duties, levies, or prices of components/spares during the currency of the AMC shall not affect the agreed AMC rates. No additional claim on account of such variations shall be entertained by SETS.

13. Penalty

- a) In the event of delay in attending breakdown complaints or carrying out preventive maintenance beyond the prescribed time schedule, the contractor shall be liable to pay a penalty at the rate of 0.5% of the quarterly AMC value per week for the first week of delay and 1% per week for subsequent delays, subject to a maximum of 10% of the AMC value.
- b) If the contractor fails to rectify the reported faults/breakdowns within the stipulated period, SETS reserves the right to get the work carried out through an alternate agency at the risk and cost of the defaulting contractor.
- c) Repeated failure in providing satisfactory AMC services, non-attendance of complaints, or non-compliance with contractual obligations may result in cancellation/termination of the AMC contract at the discretion of SETS.

14. Resolution of Disputes:

- a) Any dispute or difference arising between the contractor and SETS in connection with the AMC contract, which cannot be resolved amicably through mutual discussions, shall first be referred to arbitration in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act.
- b) Failing such resolution, the matter shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the competent courts at Chennai only, irrespective of the location where the cause of action arises.

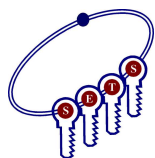

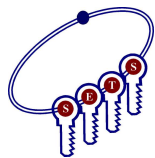

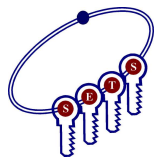
